Tuesdays

Egyptian Art, grades 1 - 3

Come explore the art of the ancient Egyptians - Pyramids, Hieroglyphics, papyrus and mummies! Let's explore a culture where the weather was warm, dry and sunny all the time. Bet they didn't have mud season!

Tumbling on Tuesdays, grades 1 - 3

Enjoy an introduction to the basics of tumbling and tumbling movements. We will explore movements which will increase coordination, balance, agility and confidence. Please have children wear clothing that allows freedom of movement.

Jedi Readers, grades 1 - 6

Come be a Jedi for an hour. Explore the Jedi world with all its action and characters through reading, listening to Star Wars stories, coloring, model making and games.

Storms and Stuff, grades 4 - 6

Do you look forward to the crack and boom of thunderstorm? Are you fascinated by thundersnow? If your answer is "yes," check out this class. We will investigate how different types of storms and weather are created and make our own simple, working models of weather instruments.

Spanish, grades 4 - 6

Come explore the Spanish language and make new amigos. Learn how to introduce yourself and ask questions to Spanish speakers. Other topics will include: calendar, colors, food, weather, and body parts. Hasta la proxima in el clase de Espanol. (See you soon in Spanish class.)

Dragonology, grades 4 - 6

Adventure into the world of dragons! Learn about different types of dragons, where they live, what (or who) they eat, and how to escape a dragon's gaze. Create your own dragon to take home.

Wednesdays

Math Games, grades 1 - 3

Play fun math games with friends! These games will help you sharpen your math skills, but they are not your ordinary math games. You will be able to move around, talk to friends, stretch, and work with hands-on materials while practicing skills.

Lego Jr., grades 1 - 3

Challenge your construction skills and have fun with friends! In this class, you can work with materials from many different kits. Follow the directions or create something original.

Spring Gardening, part one, grades 1 - 6

Though the ground is still frozen, it is time to think spring! Learn about plants and how they grow. Help design the school garden for planting in June.

Orienteering, grades 4 - 6

Never get lost in the woods again! This class will introduce you to the basics of orienteering (using a compass to get around). Most classes will take place outside, so be prepared to be outdoors having fun and learning to navigate with skill.

Nature Detectives, grades 4 - 6

Use all your senses to understand nature. In this class, you will spend time outside discovering the natural world. Learn about adaptations plants and animals use to survive winter, identify winter twigs, dissect owl pellets, track animals, and welcome the rebirth of nature in the spring. You will focus on observation, recording, and drawing to get to know nature.

Jedi Readers, grades 4 - 6

You can become a Jedi, too - a Jedi Reader! Feel the Force by reading about Jedi powers, good versus evil, heroes and villains, the Jedi force, and the Imperial force. Come learn about Star Wars!

Thursdays

Lego Jr., grades 1 - 3

Challenge your construction skills and have fun with friends! In this class, you can work with materials from many different kits. Follow the directions or create something original.

Muffin Making, grades 1 - 6

Muffins are yummy and fun to make. We will make healthy, tasty muffins to eat and share. Learn to follow a recipe, measure ingredients, and use kitchen tools. Enjoy a warm muffin while writing the recipe in a cookbook to take home.

Weaving, grades 4 - 6

Weaving is just one way to upcycle! Join us while we help the environment by turning something old into something new. We will weave on CDs and use hula hoops and t-shirts to create rugs.

Lego Architecture, grades 4 - 6

This is a special session of Lego Architecture. In this class, you will work with a professional architect to learn the basics of building design and construction. Then, working in a design team, you will plan and build your own unique structure. Be ready to stretch your architectural mind muscle and be a team-player.

Yoga for Youngsters, grades 1 - 3

What can your body do? In this class, you will find out. Improve your balance, flexibility, and strength. Did you know that your body and mind are connected? You will also learn what you can do with your body to have more peace of mind.

Got Government?, grades 4 - 6

Come to this class to learn about the branches of government, how laws are made, and how the court system works. Use this knowledge to create an imaginary country of your own.

Gross Science, grades 4 - 6

Ever wonder what is under your skin or why bread turns green? Gross Science will explore some very important natural processes. Find out why, gross as they might be, we humans cannot live without them. Activities will include hands-on experiments/ simulations discussions demonstrations and videos
